



## Reaching Youth

- 1,504 students from 13 schools participated during Forest Field Days
- 686 students from 9 schools learned at the Oregon Logging Conference
- 120 kindergarden students learned about trees in partnership with Lane County History Museum
- 52 8th graders participated in stewardship activities
- 20 high school students explored how mathematics is used in forestry



## Engaging Adults

- 250 teachers, parents, and chaperones learned alongside students during Forest Field Days and at the Oregon Logging Conference
- 50 university students from forest biology and architecture classes learned about working forests while touring a tree farm
- 8 teachers experienced forest management during the 'Seedling to Sawmill Tour' educational tour

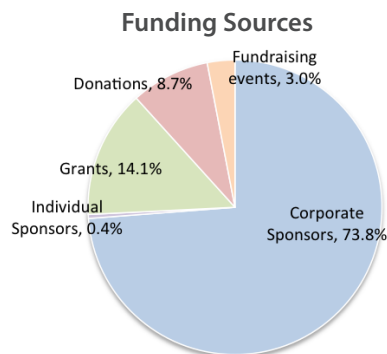


## Growing Support

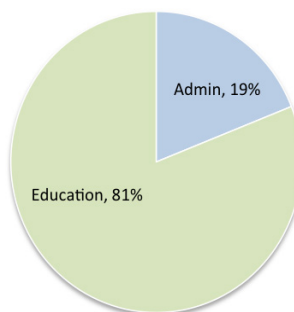
- 12 people from local agencies and industry joined our dedicated pool of over 200 volunteers
