

- 1,733 students from 16 schools participated during Forest Field Days
- 115 5th grade students toured a tree farm to learn about working forests
- 31 high school students explored how mathematics is used in forestry
- 100 children and parents learned how forests protect waterways during a public program in the community



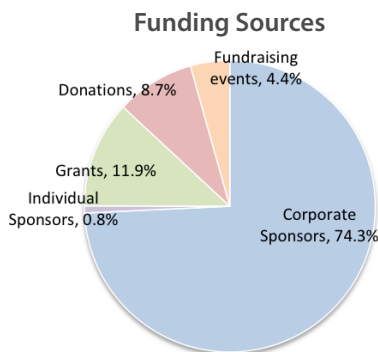
- 278 teachers, parents, and chaperones learned alongside students during Forest Field Days
- 81 university students from forest biology and architecture classes learned about working forests while touring a tree farm
- 14 teachers experienced forest management during the 'Seedling to Sawmill Tour' educational tour

- Three new schools signed on to the Forest Field Days program
- 23 people from local agencies and industry joined our dedicated pool of over 200 volunteers
- New partnerships were established, such as one with OSU Extension
- 134 people from over 30 organizations attended our annual meeting

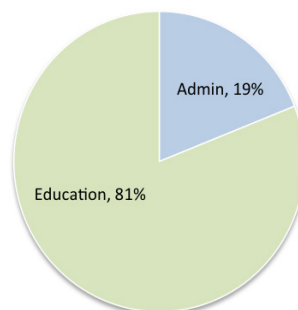


Funding Sources
