

# Connecting K-12 to Oregon's Forests



- 1,919 middle school students from 18 schools participated in Forest Field Days
- 951 4th & 5th grade students from 11 schools visited the Oregon Logging Conference
- 316 high school students learned about careers in the forest sector with our new career education program
- 115 5th grade students toured a working forest
- 350 6th graders learned about forestry during Outdoor School

- 374 teachers, parents, and chaparones learned alongside students during K-12 programs
- 24 elementary teachers participated in the 'Seedling to Sawmill Tour'
- 80 university students from various disciplines learned about forest practices during working tree farm tours

## Growing Organizational Awareness




- 27 new people from local agencies and industry joined our dedicated pool of over 150 volunteers


