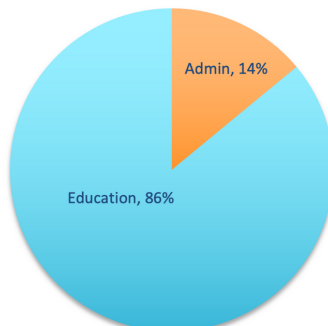
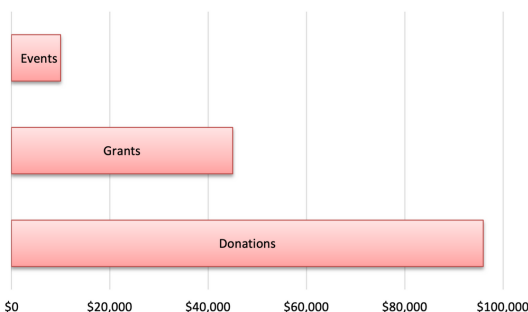
1,831 students were exposed to forest careers by meeting professionals in the field and through classroom engagement
